MATCH INFORMATION:

Eligibility: UMASC has applied for a provisional license with the UKC. As this is a non-licensed match, **dogs do not have to be UKC registered**, have a Limited Privilege (LP), or Temporary Listing (TL) number in order to participate. The judge does not need to be a licensed UKC judge; however they must follow all UKC rules, guidelines and policies in accordance with that event. All participants and attendees are required to sign a waiver.

This event will be run in accordance with the official UKC Nosework rules that can be found at <http://www.ukcdogs.com/Web.nsf/WebPages/DogEvents/Nosework>

Refunds: Participants may request a full refund before the closing date. After the closing date no refunds will be issued. Move Ups are offered day of show. Substitution Policy: Once a team is notified they are entered, the handler may substitute another dog at the same level.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION:

La Porte is on Chicago time - Central Standard Time

Entries must check in 15 minutes before class time. No training of any kind in the ring. Bring your own water.

There will be an area to watch the match. If you are in the class, do not watch until after you have completed your run. A match is a great place to work on distraction training, please be considerate of not making loud noises. Conversation at a lower level is acceptable. Don't give the hide away though! No double handling. Do not bring dogs into the viewing area. Plan on naturally occurring noise, such as printers, doors opening, dogs crated in an adjacent room, and possibly background music.

There is a room for crating, please keep your dog crated unless they are on deck or in the hole.

Make checks payable to: **UMASC**. Checks will be deposited on closing date or after.

NSF checks returned constitute an invalid entry. A returned check charge of \$20.00 will be charged to any check returned as NSF.

TIPS FOR FILLING OUT THE UKC NOSEWORK ENTRY FORM

Because this is a match, you can enter multiple levels. Enter the level you are at and a level or two above for extra practice for the next step.

Handlers may enter and handle more than one dog provided each dog is entered in a different level. You will fill out one entry from for each dog.

Below is a description of each area you need to fill out - start at the top of the form

Host Club: UMASC
Date: 1/31/16
Trial: Check the first box Trial 1

Dogs UKC Number: If your dog has a UKC registration number check the box for what type of registration your dog has then write the number to the far right on the line provided. Because this is match, a UKC registration number is not required. If your dog does not have a number please write N/A on the line.

Please continue to fill in your dog's information and your information. You must include a phone number so we can reach you the day of the trial if needed. If the weather is not safe to drive, we will cancel the trial. **Also, if the parking lot is too icy, we will cancel.** You must also provide us with an email address so we may send out your confirmation email.

Your dog's name refers to their official registered name. In most cases that is several words. Your dog's call name refers to what you call him/her by and is normally only one word. For example a dog's name might be: Bear Ridge's Dark Star Rising. That dog's call name might be: Star.

Event Entry: Please ignore the Handler Discrimination, and Nosework Trials Sections. We are not offering these at this match.

In the section that says Pre-Trial trials check PT 1 (Novice) and/or PT 2 (Advanced) and/or PT 3 (Superior). Enter all 3 to practice if you like – it's a match. We are not offering PT 4 or PT 5.

In the Individual Element Section, check Container and/or Interior. Check Novice and/or Advanced and/or Superior. We are not offering Master or Elite at this trial. Check A or B. **Entries will run in "B" if no designation in indicated.** In order to enter the A class you must meet all of the following criteria:

1. You do not have a Nosework title at this level in any venue.
2. You own the dog your are running
3. You are not paid to teach Nosework to others.

If you meet all three of these criteria then check the A box. If you do not meet all three of these then you will check the B box. Exception – if you are an A dog, BUT you want enter upper levels, enter B, except for the highest level you enter.

Search Cue: write the word that you say to tell your dog to begin to search. Time will start when you give your search cue or cross the start line whatever happens first.

Alert Response: list up to three alert responses.

- Nosework trials will include a pre-trial for the levels being run. Dogs need to pass the pre-trial for the level they are competing in. Dogs may be entered prior to passing, but must pass the pre-trial prior to competing that day. If the dog has passed on ORT in the applicable odor please submit a copy of proof.
- Individual element classes are divided into Levels "N"- "E" and further divided into "A" and "B" sections depending on the experience of the dog and/or handler. Be sure to check the rules regarding the divisions. For these classes, dogs will only be searching the elements chosen.
- Full Nosework Trials are divided into Levels "N"- "E" and further divided into "A" and "B" sections depending on the experience of the dog and/or handler. These trials contain all four elements. Each element passed earns a leg toward a title in that element.
- Handler Discrimination. One glove will be used and must be provided by the handler.
- All entries must be submitted on the current "Official UKC® Nosework Trial Entry Form".
- Use a separate entry form for each dog entered in a club's event.
- Nosework events are open to all UKC registered breeds and mixed-breed dogs with a valid Performance Listing/Limited Privilege number/Permanent Registration/Temporary Listing.
- We want you to keep the points earned at UKC Licensed events. Important things to remember:
 - All dogs entering UKC events must be permanently registered, have a valid Temporary Listing Number, or a Performance Listing/Limited Privilege number.
 - Dog not UKC registered? Apply for a Temporary Listing Number (TL) online at www.ukcdogs.com or call the Dog Events Department at (269) 343-9020. (TL fees are non-refundable, non-transferable and do not apply to the cost of permanent registration.)
 - All entry forms must be completed and signed. Incorrect information submitted on the entry form may invalidate your wins.

WAIVER

All events are held under the Official Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs or firearms will be allowed on the grounds or in the buildings on the day of a UKC Licensed event.
